Awakening Christianity in America (1620-40)

In 1620, in the midst of massive persecution, one small church had "... a great hope and inward zeal they had of laying some good foundation, or at least make some way thereunto, for the propagating and advancing the gospel of the kingdom of Christ in those remote parts of the world; yea, though they should be but even as steppingstones unto others for the performing of so great a work." -William Bradford

The 1st Great Awakening (1730-55)

A wave of revival swept the colonies and zeal for God reached a fever pitch. In 1750 Jonathan Mayhew preached in 1750 a message called "A discourse concerning unlimited submission and non-resistance to the high towers".

A young John Adams said he read it over and over "until the substance of it was incorporated into my nature and indelibly engraved on my memory." He also called that sermon the "catechism" for the American revolution.

2nd Great Awakening (1790-1840)

The "holiness" teaching of John Wesley flourished through the "circuit riders and thousands were swept up into the zeal for _____ sin in one's life and in society. Reforms took the shape of social movements for temperance, women's rights, and the abolition of slavery.

3rd Great Awakening, (1855-1930)

One key element was the renewed interest in and dependence upon the Holy Spirt, as experience in the Azusa Street Revival in Los Angeles in 1906. Today there are more than 500m Kingdom minded-Charismatic Christians in the world. The Pew Forum on Religion and Public Life asserts that these "renewalist movements" are the world's _____ growing religious movement.
